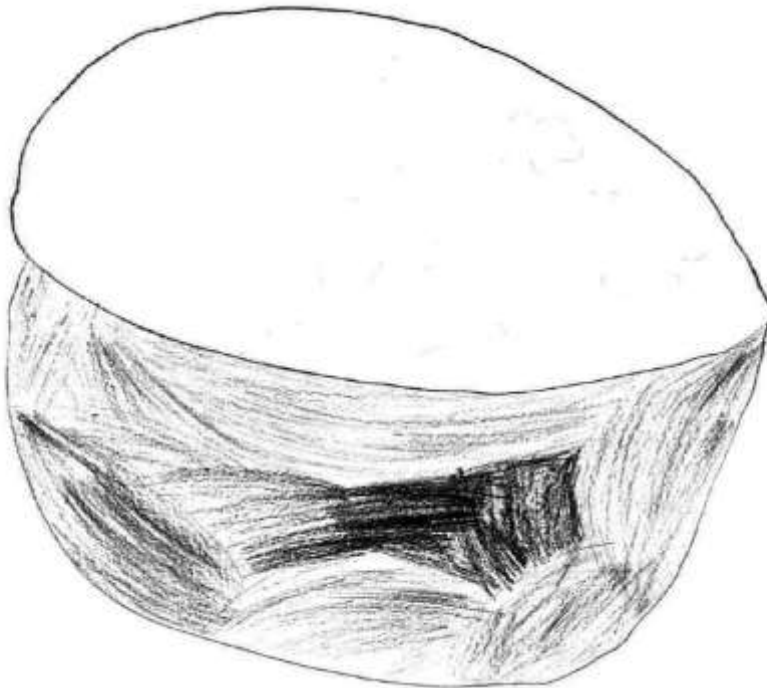


End Stage 1 English student work sample – Grade C

Grade Commentary

A range of strategies has been used to spell words and the punctuation is simple but correct.
